



Dear Business Partner,

Chevron Canada Resources conducts pre-site health and on-site verification screening for all personnel entering a Chevron location. Previously this has been done via email exchange between our onsite Medic or HES representative and your employee. This email is to notify you of a change in how the pre-site health screening is to be completed.

Action Required

- Effective immediately, all workers are asked to complete pre-site health screening using our online Site Access Screening (SAS), [SAS Tool link](#) . Pre-site health screening is to be completed by all workers prior to their arrival on a Chevron location. Workers can go to the [SAS Tool link](#) or scan the below QR code to access the SAS Tool, set up a user profile and complete their pre-site health screening. There is no application to install in order to use this tool.
- Workers will continue with site arrival screening and daily temperature checks. Workers will be denied site entry for refusal to complete their pre-screening questionnaire. Additionally, anyone with flu-like symptoms, returning from international travel in the past 14 days or having contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 will be denied entry to the work site.
- Please cascade this message to your workers and supervisors supporting Chevron operations.
